

**Please note:**

- **Hotel where most participants are booked is the Villanova Conference Center, 601 County Line Road, Radnor, PA. 19087**
- **ACSIS meeting will be held at Garey Hall room 10A (Garey Hall is across from the new Villanova University law building).**
- **From the airport, there are several ways to get to the hotel (Villanova Conference Center):**
  - A. **Taxi:** around \$60. Mainline Taxi: 610-664-0444; Rosemont Taxi: 610-525-1770; Executive Car Service: 610-825-9110
  - B. **Main Line Airport Service:** This limousine service runs direct from Philadelphia International Airport to Villanova University. For more information, phone 610-525-0513.
  - C. **Shuttle:** about \$ 42-50; From the airport call Lady Liberty Shuttle (215)724-8888
  - D. **Train:** Ask the attendant at the airport baggage counter to direct you to the train station. Purchase a combination ticket to the Radnor Station. All trains (including the SEPTA's Regional Rail Line, R1 (Airport Line) go to the 30th Street Station in Philadelphia. At 30th Street, change trains and board the SEPTA's Regional Rail Line, R5 (Paoli Local) train to Radnor Station. Call taxi (see above numbers for taxi) from the station to bring you to Villanova University Convention Center.
  - E. **Car:** If using GPS locator, please enter 629 County Line Road, Radnor, PA. 19087 Take I-95 South to Rt. 476 North (Plymouth Meeting). Follow Rt. 476 North to Exit 13 (St. David's/Villanova#). At the bottom of the exit ramp, proceed straight at the traffic light onto King of Prussia Road. Follow King of Prussia Road to the 2nd traffic light and turn Right onto Matsonford Road. Follow Matsonford Road approximately 1 mile and turn Right at the 3rd traffic light onto County Line Road. The Conference Center is the 2nd entrance on the right #marked by a small blue sign on the stone gates (keep an eye on sign as it is easy to miss).

## **DIRECTIONS TO GAREY HALL**

- **FROM VILLANOVA CONFERENCE CENTER**

Garey Hall is one mile away from the Villanova Conference Center. Participants may arrange for group taxi rides to Garey Hall. Please inquire from the hotel desk about cabs.

- **FROM PHILADELPHIA**

- **BY CAR**

- **From 476 South:**

1. Follow I-476 South to Exit 13 (Villanova/St. Davids) and bear right.
2. Head east on Lancaster Avenue (continue under the overpass)
3. Make left at fourth traffic light onto Spring Mill Road (Shell station at the corner)
4. Continue on Spring Mill Road until you reach the traffic light at the corner of Spring Mill and County Line Road.
5. Turn right onto County Line Road and make your first right at "Villanova School of Law" sign.
6. Continue immediately right and follow the path around the building until you reach the small circular drive.
7. You will see two Alumni Association Guest parking spots at the end of the drive.
8. Entrance to Garey Hall is through the glass doors on your left.
9. Ask at the Reception Area for the appropriate parking permit, which you will be provided to display in your dashboard.

- **From 476 North:**
  1. Take I-476 North to Exit 13 (Villanova/St.Davids) and turn right at traffic light onto Route 30 East (Lancaster Avenue).
  2. Make left at third traffic light onto Spring Mill Road.

**Follow steps 4 to 9 above.**
  
- **From Haverford/Bryn Mawr/Villanova (traveling on rt. 30 west):**
  1. Follow Rt. 30 West (Lancaster Avenue) past Villanova University.
  2. Turn Right onto Spring Mill Road (Rt. 320). (Shell gas station on corner).

**Follow steps 4 to 9 above.**
  
- **BY TRAIN/TROLLEY**
  - **From R5 SEPTA Station (Philadelphia)**
    1. Get off at Villanova Station.
    2. Exit train and bear right at SEPTA cafe.
    3. Continue to follow walkway up the hill (you will see a parking garage on your right).
    4. Garey Hall will be the building immediately in front of you at the top of the slight hill.
  
  - **From R5 SEPTA Station (Paoli)**
    1. Get off at Villanova station
    2. Exit train and take the pedestrian tunnel under the tracks.
    3. Exit tunnel and bear right at SEPTA cafe.
    4. Continue to follow path up the hill (you will see a parking garage on your right).
    5. Garey Hall will be the building immediately in front of you at the top of the slight hill.
